In April 2002 Delray Beach Sister Cities hosted a visit by a delegation of Tanzanians from our Sister City of Moshi. Moshi is a beautiful city nestled at the base of Mount Kilimanjaro, the great mountain, rising 20,000 feet out of the African Savannah.

Commemorating this visit, a Baobab tree, named *Rafiki*, was planted on the western lawn of Old School Square. *Rafiki* means friend in the language of Swahili, and is a fitting reminder of our bond of friendship with Moshi, Tanzania.
